PICK-UP:

Campers **CANNOT** be dropped off to camp early. The Camp pick up and drop off window is between **8:30AM-1:10PM**. Campers picked up later than 1:10PM will be subject to a charge of **\$30 per child after camp pick up has commenced**.

Campers:

Below is a list of required camper attire and items that should be at camp:

- Dressed in Athletic Attire, Athletic or Close Toed Shoes (NO SANDALS) and NO jewelry or small accessories
- A non-glass refillable water bottle
- A Morning Snack (NO NUTS)
- A lunch or additional snacks (NO NUTS)
- NO food that needs to be warmed
- NO TECH (Phones, iPad, Tablets, Kindles etc.)
- Personal Belongings must be marked with initials or name
